## SENIORS

- **CAP AND GOWNS** will be distributed on Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup> at lunch outside the student store.
- **SENIOR FINALS:** June 1 and 4 (regular schedule)
- Sunday June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 2pm we invite seniors and their families to join us in the PAC for **BACCALAUREATE**. This event is not affiliated with the International Baccalaureate Program. This event kicks off the week of graduation activities. The senior class has invited four clergy from the community to share words of wisdom and encouragement as the Class of 2018 begins their journey into life beyond high school. Seniors are asked to wear their gowns, but no caps, over dressy slacks or dresses.
- **GRADUATION REHEARSAL** will be Tuesday, June 5 (report to designated room) at 8:15 and Wednesday, June 6 at 8:15 (report to assigned seating in gym). Tickets will be distributed after practice on June 5<sup>th</sup> immediately following practice to the graduate only. **ATTENDANCE MANDATORY!!**

- Your **learn account** will be disabled immediately after you graduate, including your drive. Please ensure you SAVE ALL important files to another personal drive before June 8. Accounts are NOT deleted. The accounts are disabled as soon as the Seniors graduate. Seniors should be backing up the document they want to save.
- The **SENIOR SOURCE** is now available and has been posted on the school website (nphs.org). Go to "QuickLinks," click on "Senior Class Information." You will see "Newsletter for Grads and Their Parents: Senior Source (Spring 2018)." All the info you need, along with the necessary forms, can be found in the Senior Source.
- **TRANSCRIPTS** – Now is the time to order your final transcript to be sent to colleges in June! Come by the counselling department or room A-1 to pick up a "Request for Final Transcript" order form. When you return the completed form, please supply:
  1. Two (2) White 4 X 9 ½ inch envelopes, each with a 50¢ stamp or 1 forever stamp
    - One envelope addressed to the Admissions Office of your fall college
    - One envelope addressed to the graduating student sent to your home address – DO NOT OPEN - extra transcript for an emergency.
  2. \$10.00 **CASH ONLY**
  3. **Return completed form and addressed envelopes to the counseling office or the Office of the Registrar in room A-1 by Friday, June 8, 2018.** The envelopes need to be legible.

- **Attention students: Due to the pool renovation, there is NO STUDENT PARKING near the stadium for the remainder of the school year. This includes practices and contests before or after school.**
- **Students are not allowed to use the bathrooms in the faculty cafeteria.** Those bathrooms are for faculty & staff only. Thank you for your cooperation.
- Students please remember to stay within designated areas during **LUNCH TIME**. Students are not to be upstairs or on the backside of the D building, unless walking directly to a classroom.
- **LUNCHTIME TUTORING CENTERS AND AFTER SCHOOL TUTORING: Times and locations:** Writing Center B12 Lunch M-F, Math Center D22 Lunch M-Th, Science Center C5 Lunch M-Th. The after-school tutoring center location is permanently being moved from the cafeteria **to B12**. We are open Monday-Thursday from 2:15-3:30 and you can get help/tutoring in any subject area.
- **PLANNED STUDENT ABSENCES:** If your student is planning to be absent from school for one or more days (college visits, vacation, etc.), please have them complete a **Planned Student** Absence form at least two weeks prior to absence if possible. You can find this form on our website and at the attendance office counter. A written request with an explanation from a parent for the absence must be attached. It is submitted to the Dean of Attendance for review then taken by the student to each of their teachers for signature.
- **ATTENTION STUDENTS WHO DRIVE TO SCHOOL:** This year, students who have parked at Borchard Park have done a fantastic job parking only in the designated spaces. Thank you very much. Your cooperation is appreciated by Borchard staff members and NPHS administration. However, please be advised that if you park on campus, you **must** park in the designated student parking lot. At no time may any student park in any part of the staff lots, whether or not the spots are specifically marked. This includes the spots in front of the A building parking lot. Staff lots are between the two driveway entrances, and along the B, C, & D buildings. Students who park in these off-limits areas will be fined and required to move their cars.
- **ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS:** You must use the crosswalk at Lesser Drive or the near the Marquee if you need to walk across Reino coming to and from school. Walking to the stoplight is not nearly as inconvenient as causing an accident. Laws are in place for your safety and the safety of others.
